NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited for the following posts of Special Judicial Magistrates of II Class in Vizianagaram Judicial District from the persons who are having the under-mentioned qualifications. Applications duly filled in should be reached to the office of undersigned **on or before 30-11-2024 by 05:00 p.m.**, the later will not be considered.

1. Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, Excise, Vizianagaram.
2. Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, Parvathipuram.
3. Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, Bobbili.
4. Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, Salur.
5. Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, Kothavalasa.

I. Qualifications :-

A Person shall be qualified for appointment as Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, if a person

- i. held any post in Andhra Pradesh State Judicial Service and retired or resigned; or
- ii. held a post in the Andhra Pradesh Judicial Ministerial Subordinate Service not below the rank of Superintendent (Category-III of Andhra Pradesh Judicial Ministerial Subordinate Service Rules, 2019) in the State of Andhra Pradesh and has a Law Degree; or
- iii. held a post of Section Officer and above in the Andhra Pradesh High Court service and has a Law Degree; or
- iv. practiced as an advocate at least for five years and at present not on the rolls of the Bar Council.
- v. being any retired Gazetted Officer possessing Law Degree or who has passed the criminal judicial test in full consisting of Indian Penal Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure or the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 conducted by the Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission and who has exercised Magisterial powers during his tenure of service for not less than three years;
Provided that a suitable retired Judicial Officer shall be given preference.

II. Disqualifications :-

A person

- i. who is practicing advocate; or
- ii. who is a member of any State or local authority; or
- iii. who is a member of the State Legislature or the Parliament; or
- iv. having held an offence under the State or the Union Government or any local authority, has been dismissed or removed or compulsorily retired from service or subjected to any other major penalty for misconduct; or

- v. who has been convicted and sentenced by a court for an offence involving moral delinquency or is charged of any offence constituting moral turpitude and proceedings are pending; or
- vi. of unsound mind or who is deaf or mute or blind or suffering from leprosy or any other contagious disease; or
- vii. in a bigamous marriage.
- viii. a woman whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time such marriage.
- ix. adjudicated as an insolvent or an undischarged insolvent, or
- x. being contractor or a business man or one interested in a subsisting contract or any work being done for Central or State Government or a local authority within whose limits the Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class has to discharge his duties.

shall not be eligible.

III. Age :

Non-Practicing advocate with a practice at the Bar of not less than five years and who is above 45 years and below 65 years of age in respect of retired persons who have at least one and half years to complete 65 years of age, as on the date of notification, shall alone be eligible.

IV. Holding of Court :

The Special Judicial Magistrates of II Class should hold Court work for 5(five) days in a week i.e. from Monday to Friday on working days from 07:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

V. Honorarium :

The honorarium/remuneration payable to the Special Judicial Magistrates of II Class shall presently be @ Rs.45,000/- (Rupees Forty Five Thousand) per month and Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) per month towards conveyance, subject to enhancement of the same by the Government, from time to time.

VI. Revocation of powers of Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class :

- i. If any complaint as to the misconduct of the Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class is received by the High Court, the same shall be placed before the Committee dealing with the subject. If, on perusal of the complaint, the Committee is of the opinion that the officer has resorted to any acts of misconduct, or has derelicted his duties, a show cause notice, of not less than 15 days, requiring him to explain, shall be issued.

On consideration of the explanation offered by the Officer, if the Committee finds that any act of misconduct or dereliction of duty was resorted by the Officer, Committee may make appropriate recommendation, for termination of the services of the officer, which in turn shall be forwarded to the Government. The order so passed would be final.

- ii. On appointment and while in service, a Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class may be removed without being called upon to show cause if he fails to attend three consecutive sittings of the Court without a written permission of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate.
- iii. Powers conferred by the Court on Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class shall automatically stand withdrawn on attaining the age of 65 years.

VII. The application for the above said posts should invariably contain the following particulars :

- iii. Address for communication with cell phone number
- iv. Qualifications
- v. Date of birth
- vi. Date of retirement
- vii. Name of the post to which applied
- viii. Designation of the post at the time of retirement
- ix. Period during which he/she exercised II Class Magistrate powers (proof of certificate to be enclosed)
- x. Other remarks, if any

VIII. Documents to be submitted along with the application/bio-data :

Attested copies of

- i. Date of birth certificate (SSC or SSLC) and copy of proceedings issued at the time of retirement.
- ii. Certificates in proof of educational qualifications
- iii. Proof of certificates regarding departmental tests passed (four papers test consisting of I.P.C. and Cr.P.C.)
- iv. Pension Payment Order.
- v. Service Certificate if available.
- vi. Proof exercising Magisterial powers together with period while in service in Gazetted post.
- vii. Non-practicing certificate in case of Advocates and certificates showing practice at the Bar

IX. Other conditions :

- i. Applications with insufficient information and without proof of certificates will be rejected and no further correspondence will be entertained.
- ii. The undersigned reserves right to cancel this Notification at any time without assigning any reasons.
