3. BRIEF NOTE ON PALLIATIVE CARE UNITS UNDER NHM PROGRAMME AND ACTIVITIES:-

It is submitted the Government have introduced Palliative Care to promote quality of life, provide treatment and support the family to cope up with the suffering and pain. The Palliative Care is provided in the Hospital and at Homes of the patients. End of life care shall be provided through medicines, nursing care and physiotherapy when needed along with individual and family counseling session.

It is to inform that 10 beds allotted in each district for establishing Palliative Unit and Guidelines are issued in indenting, storage, dispensing morphine under AP Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic rules-1986 to District now necessary Human resources is required to provide seamless Palliative Care in all centres.

Activities to be done at District Early Intervention Centres:

- i. Availability and accessibility of rational, quality pain relief and palliative care to the needy, as an integral part of Health Care at all levels, in alignment with the community requirements.
- ii. Improve the capacity to provide palliative care service delivery within government health programs such as the National Program for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Cardiovascular Disease, Diabetes, and Stroke; National Program for Health Care of the Elderly; the National AIDS Control Program; and the National Rural Health Mission.
- iii. Refine the legal and regulatory systems and support implementation to ensure access and availability of Opioids for medical and scientific use while maintaining measure for preventing diversion and misuse.
- iv. Encourage attitudinal shifts amongst healthcare professionals by strengthening and incorporating principles of long term care and palliative care into the educational curricula (of medical, nursing, pharmacy and social work courses).
- v. Promote behaviour change in the community through increasing public awareness and improved skills and knowledge regarding pain relief and palliative care leading to community owned initiatives supporting health care system.
- vi. Develop national standards for palliative care services and continuously evolve the design and implementation of the National program to ensure progress towards the vision of the program.
